414 alerts posted reporting on 963 horses or in the case of vesicular stomatitis the number of premises affected\*

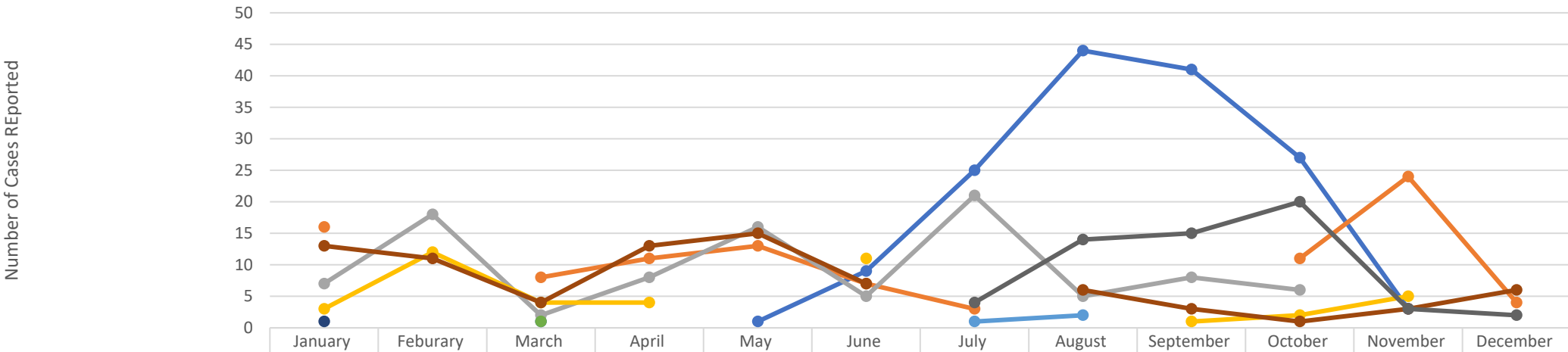
- **Anthrax:** 6 cases (6 in TX)
- **Eastern Equine Encephalitis:** 146 cases (6 in CT, 27 in FL, 1 in GA, 11 in IN, 18 in LA, 1 in ME, 8 in MA, 29 in MI, 1 in MN, 7 in MS, 1 in NH, 8 in NJ, 5 in NY, 1 in NC, 4 in OH, 6 in ON, CAN, 1 in RI, 5 in SC, 1 in TN, 1 in TX, 5 in WI)
- **Equine Herpesvirus- Abortion:** 6 cases (4 in ON, CAN, 2 in SK, CAN)
- **Equine Herpesvirus- Neurologic:** 89 cases (5 in AZ, 17 in CA, 5 in GA, 2 in ID, 1 in IN, 1 in IA, 1 in MB, CAN, 1 in MD, 1 in MN, 1 in MO, 3 in NV, 1 in NJ, 4 in NY, 3 in ND, 6 in OH, 14 in OK, 3 in ON, CAN, 2 in PA, 7 in SK, CAN, 1 in TX, 1 in UT, 7 in VA, 1 in WA, 1 in WY)
- **Equine Herpesvirus- Respiratory:** 8 cases (1 in CA, 1 in IN, 2 in NV, 2 in NY, 2 in WA)
- **Equine Infectious Anemia:** 99 cases (5 in AB, CAN, 1 in AZ, 3 in B.C., CAN, 1 in CO, 2 in FL, 5 in GA, 1 in ID, 1 in IN, 14 in IA, 1 in KS, 1 in MA, 1 in MS, 1 in NC, 1 in OK, 9 in SK, CAN, 5 in TN, 45 in TX, 2 in WI)
- **Equine Influenza:** 20 outbreaks (3 in CA, 1 in FL, 4 in IN, 1 in OH, 1 in RI, 1 in SD, 1 in TN, 8 in WA)
- **Potomac Horse Fever** 3 cases (2 in MA, 1 in NH)
- **Rabies:** 1 case (1 in GA)
- **Salmonellosis:** 1 case suspected (1 in FL)
- **Strangles:** 110 cases (1 in CT, 1 in DE, 28 in FL, 3 in HI, 1 in MA, 20 in MI, 2 in MN, 2 in MO, 2 in NV, 4 in NB, CAN, 2 in NC, 2 in OR, 3 in PA, 3 in RI, 2 in SC, 2 in TN, 1 in UT, 2 in VA, 29 in WA)
- **Vesicular Stomatitis:** 440 Premises (at least one case reported: 263 in CO, 1 in KS, 1 in NE, 38 in NM, 1 in OK, 86 in TX, 14 in UT, 37 in WY)
- **West Nile Virus:** 75 cases (1 in AL, 15 in CA, 13 in CO, 1 in CT, 9 in FL, 3 in ID, 3 in IA, 2 in KY, 1 in MI, 1 in MN, 3 in OH, 1 in ON, CAN, 1 in OR, 2 in SC, 1 in TN, 2 in WA)
